

Export Control Laws Acknowledgement & Verification

It is the responsibility of the host faculty member to ensure that the visitor only have access to fundamental research information in compliance with the export control laws of the United States of America.

Fundamental research is defined by the National Security Decision Directive 189 as basic and applied research in science and engineering, the results of which ordinarily are published and shared broadly within the scientific community, as distinguished from proprietary research and from industrial development, design, production, and product utilization, the results of which ordinarily are restricted for proprietary or national security reasons. Access to protected, proprietary, military, space information or information which is not fundamental research may be violation of export control laws.
